

Is this course for me?

This qualification is suitable for you if you want to prepare for further learning or training and/or develop knowledge and/or skills in a subject area.

What will I learn?

To achieve the qualification you must achieve the following 9 units:

- Principles of personal development in adult social care settings
- Principles of diversity, equality and inclusion in adult social care settings
- Principles of safeguarding and protection in health and social care
- Introduction to duty of care in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Understand the role of the social care worker
- Understand person-centred approaches in adult social care settings
- Understand health and safety in social care settings
- Understand how to handle information in social care settings
- Principles of communication in adult social care settings

How much does it cost?

There is no cost to the learner for courses provided under the Job Centre Plus programme where the learner is in receipt of JSA/ESA (WRAG).

How do I achieve this qualification?

This qualification requires attendance at Harrow College (Harrow-on-the-Hill campus) over a 10-week period. You are required to achieve a minimum of 20 credits.

How long will I study?

Up to 10 weeks.

What do I need to get onto the course?

- You must be in receipt of JSA/ESA (WRAG) and be referred to Harrow College by your Job Centre Plus Adviser.
- UK or EU passport holder, or ability to demonstrate 3 years of unbroken residency within the UK.
- Score at least Entry Level 3 or above on the Initial Assessment basic skills test.

How will I benefit from this qualification?

- You will have greater opportunities to develop new skills.
- You will receive recognition for your existing skills.
- You will improve your career progression opportunities by also addressing the units of the Level 1 C&G Award in Employability and Personal Development (QCF) and achieving this additional qualification.

How do I enrol?
