

### **Is this course for me?**

This qualification is suitable for you, if you would like an introduction to teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector or aim to work in a teacher/trainer role. It provides an entry point for those new to teaching and training.

### **What will I learn?**

This qualification will enable you to

- Understand own role, responsibilities and boundaries of role in relation to teaching
- Understand teaching and learning approaches in the specialist area
- Demonstrate session planning skills
- Understand how to deliver inclusive sessions which motivate learners.

### **How much does it cost?**

There is no cost to the learner for courses provided under the Job Centre Plus programme where the learner is in receipt of JSA/ESA (WRAG).

### **How do I achieve this qualification?**

This qualification requires attendance at Harrow College (Harrow-on-the-Hill campus) over a 10-week period. You are required to achieve 6 credits.

### **How long will I study?**

Up to 10 weeks to include guided learning hours and self-study.

### **What do I need to get onto the course?**

- You must be in receipt of JSA/ESA (WRAG) and be referred to Harrow College by your Job Centre Plus Adviser.
- UK or EU passport holder, or ability to demonstrate 3 years of unbroken residency within the UK.
- Score at least Entry Level 3 or above on the Initial Assessment basic skills test.

### **How will I benefit from this qualification?**

- You will have greater opportunities to develop new skills.
- You will receive recognition for your existing skills.
- You will improve your career progression opportunities by also addressing the units of the Level 1 C&G Award in Employability and Personal Development (QCF) and achieving this additional qualification.
