BPEC Water Regulations Training

This Water Regulations course has been developed by BPEC to help plumbers update their knowledge of the Water Supply (Water Fitting) Regulations 1999.

On successful completion of this course you will be awarded a Certificate of Competence. This certificate is accepted by all the 'Approved Contractor' schemes for purposes of evidence of the knowledge element of The Water Regulations Course.

COURSE CONTENT:

- Introduction and background to the Regulations.
- The Regulations
 - Materials and substances in contact with water
 - Requirements for water fittings
 - Water system design and installation
 - Commissioning (testing, flushing and sterilisation of systems)
 - Prevention of cross contamination to wholesome water
 - Backflow prevention
 - Cold water services
 - Hot water services
 - WCs, flushing devices and urinals
- Sanitary appliances and water for outside use.

SUITABILITY:

The certificate is intended primarily for practising plumbers who already have knowledge of hot and cold water systems. The course is also relevant to students nearing the end of their Level 3 course, Water board inspectors, surveyors, Housing Association consultants and any other individual involved in the design or specification of water systems, or maintenance and supervision of buildings containing water systems, including operatives with limited previous knowledge.
