How to enrol and pay

Community Learning Part-time Courses

Please note if you are eligible for fee concessions you will need to enrol in person at the college. Please bring any documents or evidence with you when you come in.

If you are paying the full fee you can enrol by any of the three methods below:

- Online - If you are paying the full fee you can enrol and pay online via our website harrow.ac.uk. Go to the course you wish to enrol on and click the Enrol Now button. This links to our online enrolment form and secure payment service. You can pay using major debit and credit cards.
- By telephone – if you are paying the full fee you pay over the telephone using call **020 8909 6000** to enrol over the telephone using a debit or credit card.
- In person – come into the college to enrol in person. You can pay in cash or by cheque (made payable to HCUC, with the card number on the back) at our Harrow on the Hill or Harrow Weald campuses.

• Community Learning courses usually run for two or three hours per week for a few weeks; enough time to master and apply a useful range of skills. Academic courses vary in duration.

• You will learn in a sociable environment with excellent teachers and facilities.

• Each course has a limited number of places. This ensures you receive the one-to-one support and access to equipment needed to facilitate your learning.

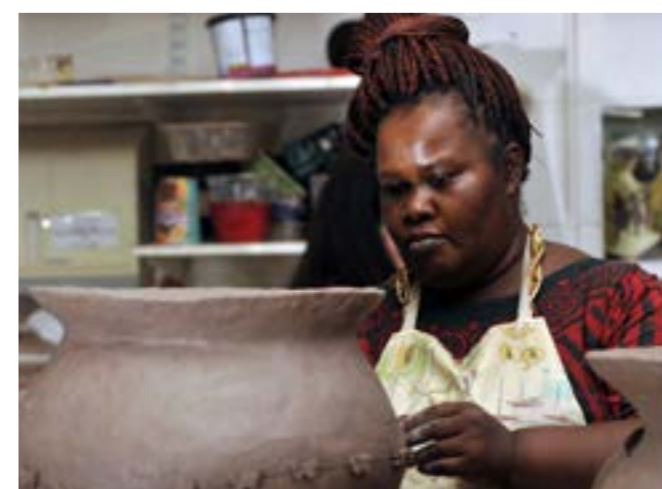
• Many courses use specialist college workshops, studios, salons or computer suites.

• Your teacher will employ a wide range of learning techniques appropriate for the course which may include: discussion, role play, question and answer sessions, written exercises, collaboration with other students and teacher demonstrations.

• Some courses start at beginner level and offer opportunities to progress to a more advanced course (where available) as your skills, knowledge and confidence develop.

Student Services

Harrow College also offers an extensive range of student services. This includes learning support for eligible students, careers and employability advice, advice on finance and safeguarding young people and vulnerable adults.



Fees and Financial Support

Financial support available will depend on the level of study and your circumstances. Fees are payable at the time of enrolment.

College registration fee and ID card fee

The fees quoted in this guide include the College registration and ID card fee.

Concessions

Concessions are available on Academic Part-Time courses marked (*) in the Fees column and on all Community Learning courses (except for ceramics).

To qualify for concessions on fees, students must meet certain criteria such as being in receipt of a range of government benefits or on a low wage.

Students eligible for concessions will pay for their ID card fee and for any other fees associated with the course, where applicable.

To check your eligibility please contact us on **020 8909 6000**.

If you are 19+ and you are working or self-employed and earn below the annual London Living Wage of £20,572.50 (£16,009.50 if you are an outer London resident) you may qualify for free tuition fees. ESOL courses are eligible for free tuition and many other subject areas at Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2 are too.

Please note: you will need to provide evidence of your earnings (wage slips or a current contract with details of your earnings) when you come to enrol and there may be other costs you do need to pay for, depending on your course.

Advanced Learner Loan (ALL)

This loan covers the cost of tuition so it doesn't have to be paid up front. Loans are available for students aged 19 and over, studying at Level 3 to Level 6 including QCF Certificates & Diplomas, Access to HE and A-levels. The minimum loan you can apply for is £300.

Examination registration fees

These are payable by all students aged 19+ and are included within the full course fee (except where fees are payable direct to the Awarding Body).



Refunds and cancellations

If the college has to cancel a course all fees will be fully refunded.

All other requests for fee refunds must be made in writing to the Finance Office.
